Dear Parents and Carers,

New 2018 Behaviour Accountability Launched

Today, we launched the school's new steps for managing behaviour in class and around the school and for making sure all pupils are as well behaved as possible at all times. These measures will help the school to respond to you as parents/carers regarding any incidents of poor or unacceptable behaviour as well as providing information for ensuring those children who are demonstrating exceptional behaviour day in day out are acknowledged accordingly.

There will be a number of key strands of our new system, such as:

- any child needing to meet their class teacher or a school senior leader to discuss the accountability for their behaviour will do so between 3.15 – 3.45 p.m. on the day of any repeated incidents or incidents of extreme unacceptable behaviour – the teacher will bring the child to the playground to be collected for 3.45 p.m.
- all children will be entitled to attend a whole school monthly event if they stay free from behaviour accountability – should your child attend such a session they will not be invited to the monthly event, which for January 2018 will be a school Talent Show and for February 2018 will be a school disco
- class teachers will arrange to meet the parent/carer of any child who behaves to a point that the school deems unacceptable and which will follow an initial warning to the child and the chance given to turn around this behaviour. A series of meetings will follow with class teachers, lead teachers and senior teachers should any pupil's behaviour not improve after such meetings have been arranged.
- any incident of reported behaviour that could be deemed as bullying will be responded without delay and in line with the school's policy and procedures for managing behaviour and discipline. This would include any incident of reported prejudice based bullying covering any behaviour deemed to be discriminatory in any way. The school will take a zero tolerance of such behaviour within Camelot School from any pupil or adult.

Thank you for your support regarding this area as we seek to make our school free of anything less than exceptional in terms of the behaviour and conduct of our pupils.
