In late 2016, the school's leaders began a campaign to challenge the standard of the pupil toilets at Camelot and to assess what could be done to improve this important area of school life which really hasn't been 'exceptional everyday'.

Unfortunately and as many of you will be aware, previous school leaders had taken decisions which had left the school with a significant financial deficit which is key factor why the school is not able to spend its own money on such necessary improvements.

To cut a long (over two year) story short, this month we have experienced receiving an amazing donation of £60,000 from a local property developer, Avanton, to complete an overhaul of the outdoor toilets in the playground. This is our first donation of such a substantial amount and this has successfully given us the opportunity to make nearly every corner of our school exceptionaleveryday!
