

### School Standards Update:


If your family is entitled to claim Pupil Premium Funding (PPF) support (linked to your family income) then the school benefits in so many ways that will support your child.

# Camelot Curriculum – 2017-18




**Below is an extract of the Camelot Curriculum overview for a sample year group— Year One.**
