# What Camelot School offers which not all neighbouring schools do:

- Our Year 6 children have received dedicated additional school support from 8.00—9.00 a.m. every day—including breakfast and daily PE lessons delivered by an excellent coach
- **Our Reception children** are invited to their Little Explorers daily provision (8.15–9.00 a.m every day) to help them prepare for their day as well as to support our parents/carers
- Free After School Clubs ranging from outdoor games (football, netball, cricket and many more) and indoor activities (dance, drama, performance). Most schools charge for clubs.
- A Family Support Team with sufficient resources to support all families in their school community and supported by additional mentoring services.
- Dedicated additional specialist teachers for PE, Music and Computing teaching
- Four halls, including a dedicated Indoor Sports Hall as well as a 3G Astro turf ballcourt
- School Football Team competing in the Saturday Southwark and Lambeth Schools League
- **Girls and Boys Football Team** competing in the schools 6-a-side league (Camelot currently 2nd and 3rd in their league.. + both teams have their own sponsored kits)
- Ofsted Inspector trained headteacher—Camelot School is Southwark's only school with a currently registered London Schools Ofsted Inspector
- Outstanding teachers in increasing numbers across the school—how do we know is we asked our Ofsted trained staff for their judgement of our staff—how many other schools can actually say their judgements are moderated in the same way
- A Saturday Community Literacy Hub— available for all parents/carers so they can enrol their child in a provision of the highest quality but at the lowest prices
