The Government have announced the plan that all schools will reopen from Monday 8th March

We believe that if this plan is going to work can we please add:

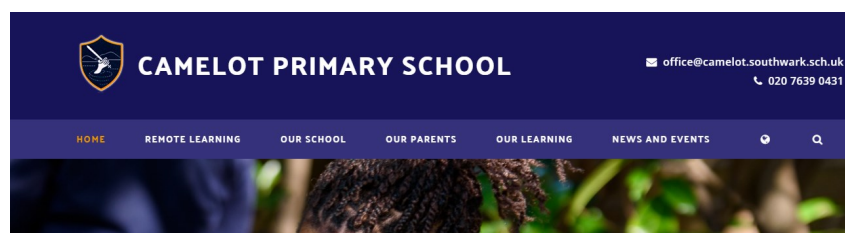
- Camelot will reopen as before the Lockdown, starting with masks requested for parents/carers dropping off and picking up children.* All staff will wear masks around the school and when not in their year group bubbles
- All children to return in school uniform—carrying a PE kit and bag on Mondays and which will stay in school for the week and to be returned on Fridays.*
(Please can we encourage an online order/supermarket trip now to buy plain coloured items to compliment other items and to be ready for March 8th)
- The times of the school day will return to provide longer gaps at the end of the day when children from different year groups are picked up. Times will be confirmed in next week's newsletter.

* Please note plans are included in our risk assessment and if there are any queries to these plans please raise these with Mr Robinson as he seeks to manage the school at this uncertain time. The current plan is to operate on this basis until the end of March 2021 and then we will review such arrangements.

Camelot 'Laptops for our Pupils' Policy going forward

The enormous task of managing laptops for all our children really starts for us on March 8th. The aim is to ensure every child in our school is provided with a laptop to have at home for the duration of their time at Camelot—a permanent loan. To be able to achieve this aim, we ask that every child brings back their school laptop from Monday 8th March and hands this to their class teacher. The school will then ensure all the appropriate licences and anti virus software are installed and then after Easter, the plan is to send a laptop home that will stay at home for weekdays, weekends, holidays and hopefully not, but if ever there is a Lockdown again.... please no!
