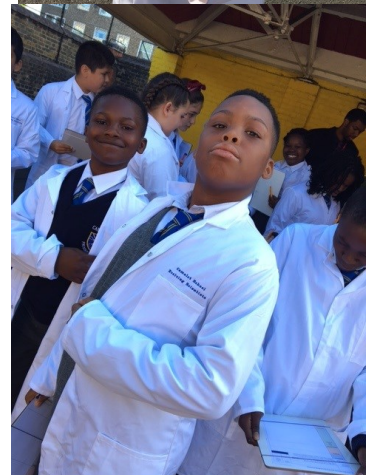
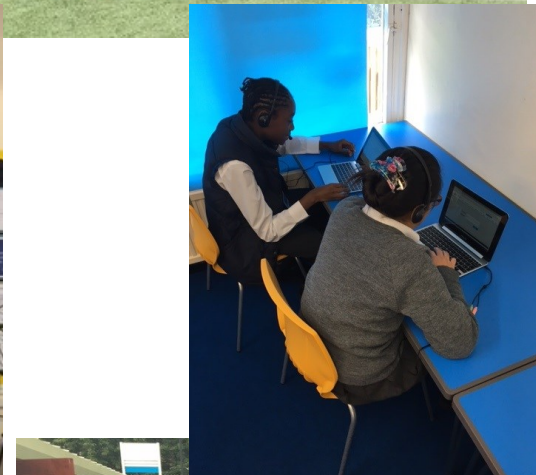
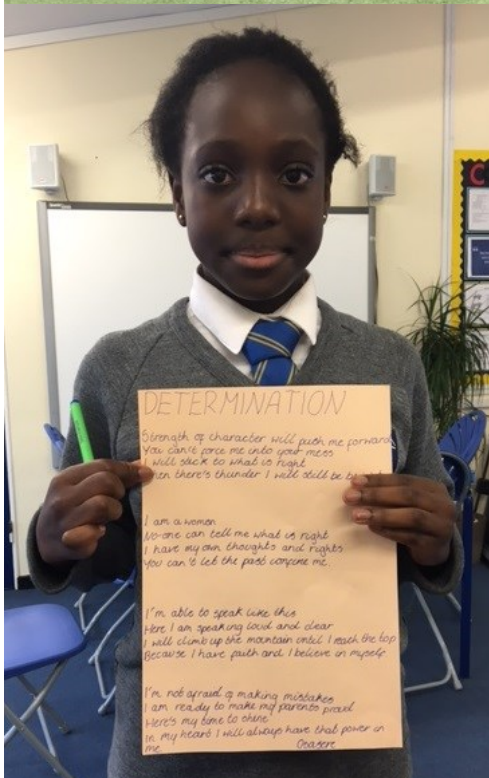
## Reminders.. Please
