






### **Attendance Matters**

### What Zone Are You In?

### What the Camelot School zones mean for parents and children?

**Green Zone**—Prize Winners—able to participate in all school events and opportunities linked to exceptional attendance

**Blue Zone**—with exceptional attendance for the rest of the year these children will get into the green zone and will be able to join in the exceptional attendance events

Yellow Zone—Attendance improvements needed and school attendance team will monitor to ensure no further issues


Orange Zone—child and family situation discussed with the school's educational welfare officer and individual attendance instructions will have to be followed, e.g. all absences needing written authorisation

**Red Zone**—Educational Welfare Officer advises that situation for the child and parent/carer is reviewed to decide what action to take. Court order, parenting orders, fines for attendance all decisions taken in these cases
