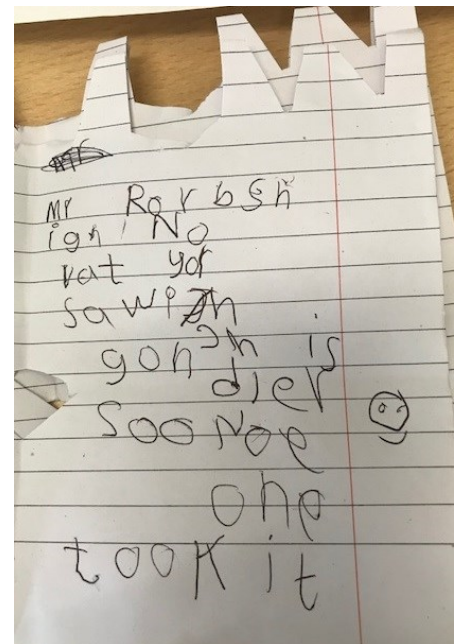
# Science week at Camelot 2018

## Reminder:

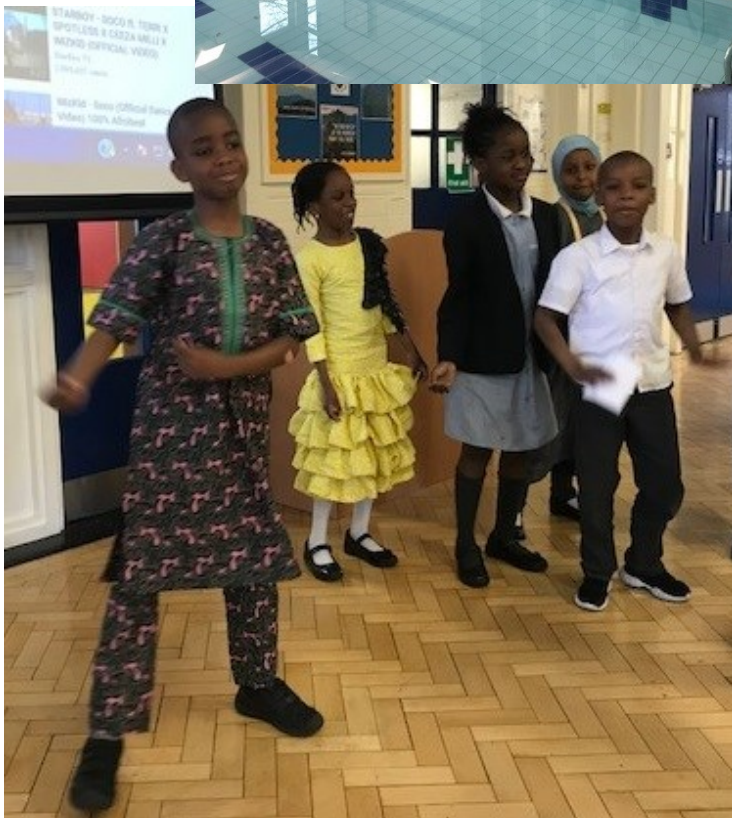
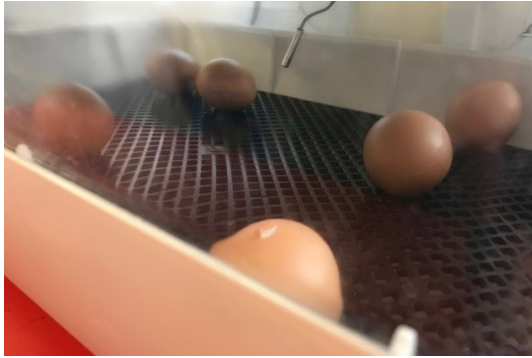
**Request from the local government polling officer that the Mauna Kea Building is closed for the election day at Camelot on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2018.**

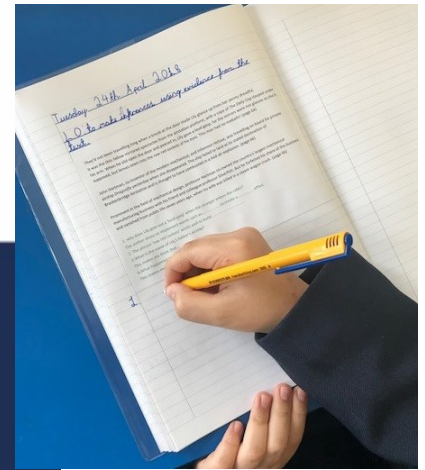

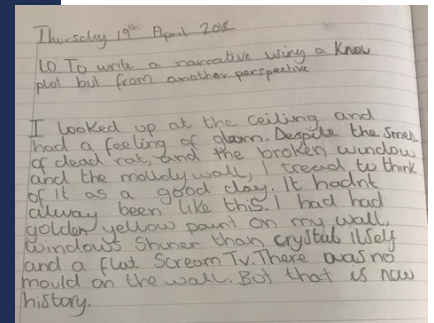
