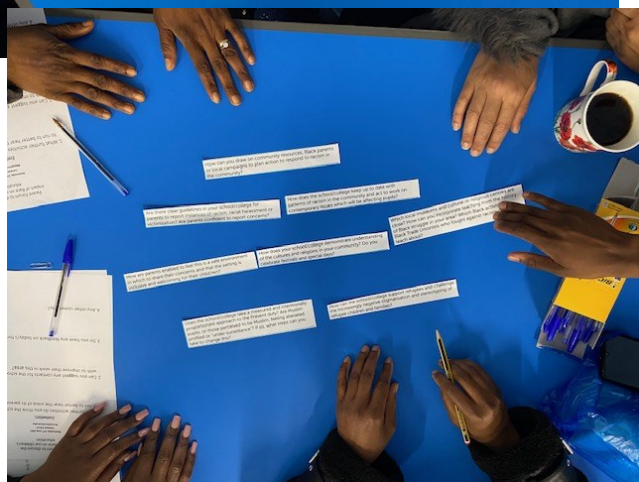
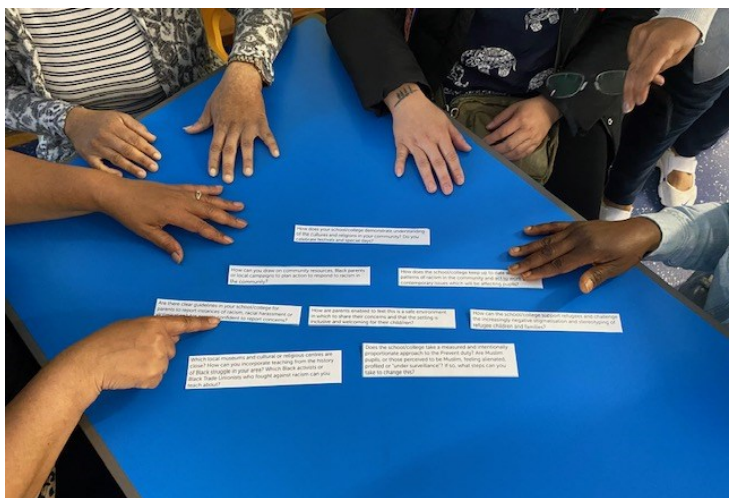

Parent Forum to discuss the impact of Race on our children's education June 2021—Meeting Number One



Aims: The school is keen to meet with those parents/carers/family members who can support us on our journey towards improving the outcomes for our children through the education they receive.

Outcome: The best Primary School in the UK for Black British pupils... simple!

Key priorities from Parents Forum:

Group 1: How does your school/college demonstrate understanding of the cultures and religions in your community? Do you celebrate festivals and special days?

Group 2: How can you draw on community resources, Black parents or local campaigns to plan action to respond to racism in the community?

Group 3: Are there clear guidelines in your school/college for parents to report instances of racism, racial harassment or victimisation? Are parents confident to report concerns?

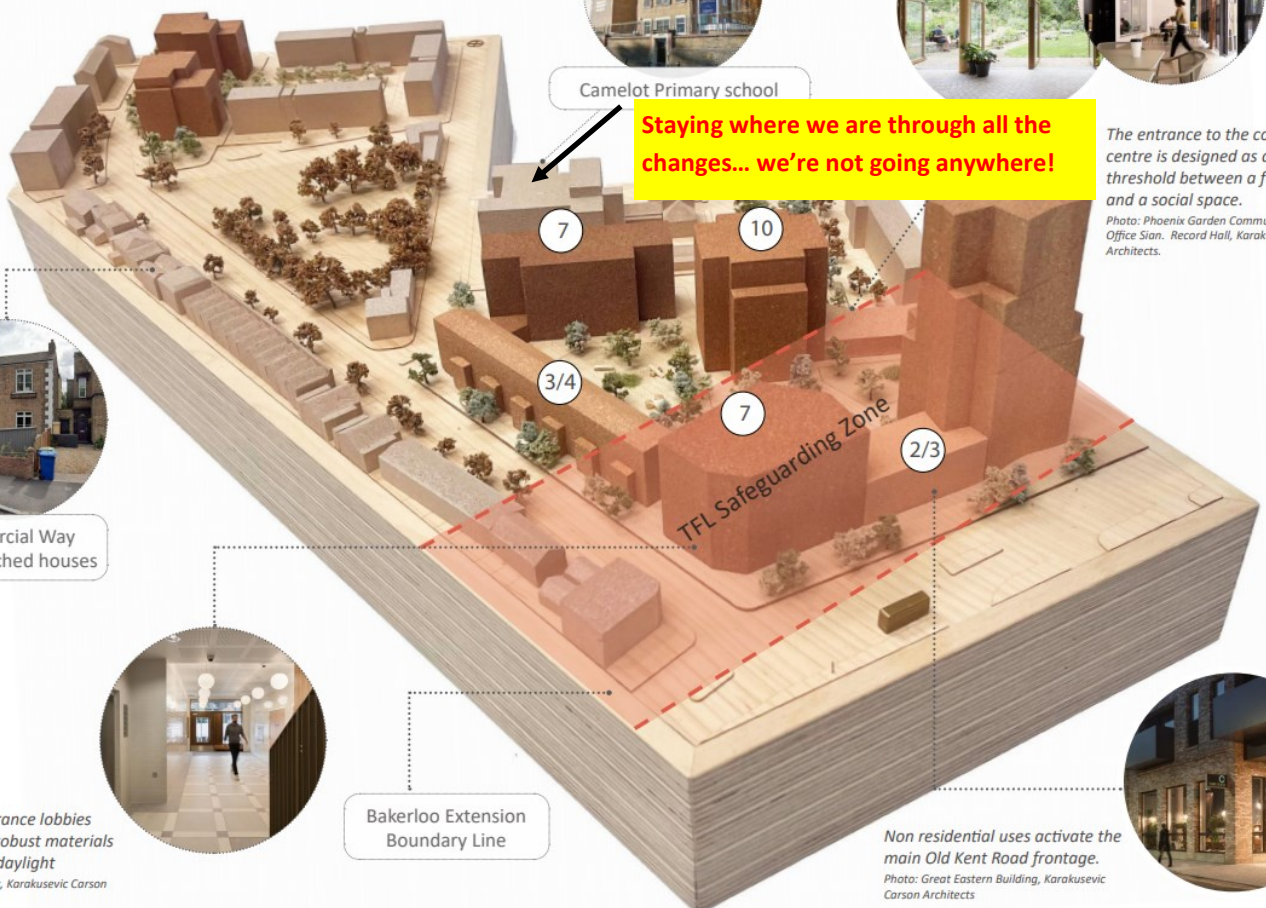
