



Pupil behaviour and discipline in well managed at the school 193 responses




#### The Camelot School Annual Parent Survey


The results are analysed by school leaders and presented to governors.

The school's priority plans are influenced by this feedback.


My child is happy at school and I have necessary feedback from the school? 194 responses




My child is progressing well at this school – even after all the time in lockdown 193 responses




The school looks after my child and provides a safe environment for them 194 responses




