#### **CHAMPS Plans**


**Camelot CHAMPS** will be for three weeks in total to support our staff to have holidavs themselves. Other providers will offer other options for the other three weeks of the summer







Surrey Cricket Foundation, England Cricket Board and Croydon Council would like to offer your Child an opportunity to be a part of a bespoke All Stars cricket (5-8 years old) & Dynamos cricket (9-11 year old) Program this summer. The Burgess Park All Stars & Dynamos cricket programmes are fully funded by Surrey Cricket Foundation and as such will be FREE to all participants.

We have 2 x options for cricket in Burgess Park which will run on Thursday mornings during the summer holidays.

The **All-Stars Cricket** program is an entry level national cricket program aimed at 5 – 8 year olds.
