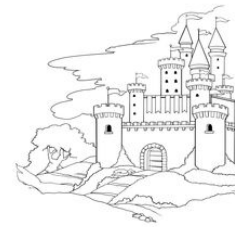

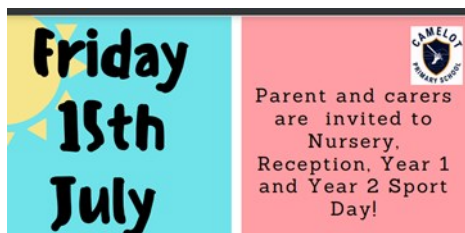

Camelot's End of Year 6 outcomes exceed national averages

We are pleased to confirm that in the key measure of pupil attainment in schools for 2022, **Camelot School has exceeded the national average** in the key area of combined Reading, Writing and Maths results.

62% of our exceptional Year 6 pupils achieved this combined outcome*, 3% above the national figure of 59% and a 9% improvement for the school from outcomes achieved prior to the recent pandemic (2019 to 2022 comparsion) whereas nationally all pupils reduced by 6% in this period.

Key stage 2 attainment: National headlines

5 July 2022



This publication provides the latest headline statistics on attainment in key stage 2 national curriculum assessments in England.

This is the first publication of key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019 due to cancellation of 2020 and 2021 assessments during the pandemic.

These statistics cover attainment in the following assessments taken by pupils at the end of year 6, when most are age 11:

- Reading test
- Maths test
- Grammar, punctuation and spelling test
- Writing teacher assessment
- Science teacher assessment

Attainment in 2022 is compared to 2019 and previous years where possible.

Headline facts and figures

These are the first key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019, after assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic

These statistics cover the attainment of year 6 pupils who took assessments in summer 2022. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 4 and in year 5.

Attainment in all of reading, writing and maths has decreased compared to 2019

59% of pupils met the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, down from 65% in 2019.

In individual subjects, attainment increased slightly in reading and fell in all other subjects compared to 2019

74% of pupils met the expected standard in reading, up from 73% in 2019.

71% of pupils met the expected standard in maths, down from 79% in 2019.

69% of pupils met the expected standard in writing, down from 78% in 2019.

Please note the key change in the school term dates that has been agreed to support Camelot's plans to work alongside Cobourg School in the next academic year. On Friday 2nd September, we will now have a shared training day and the new term will start at both schools from Monday 5th September. Thank you
